Help your child log into the Seesaw CLASS app at home:

1. For tablets or phones, download the **Seesaw Class App**
For laptop or desktop computers, go to app.seesaw.me
2. Your child logs in by clicking **I'm a Student**
3. We provided a unique Home Learning Code for your child to log in at home – see online learning logins: **Enter the text code** or **scan the QR code**

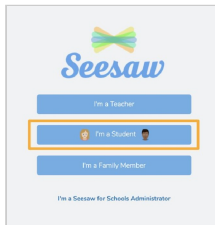

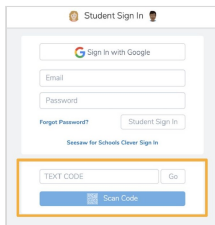
Step 1:

- ✓ Click 'I'm a Student'



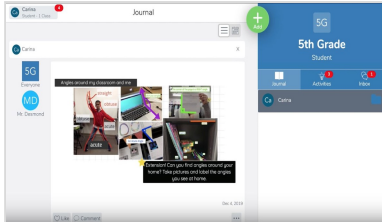
Step 3:
